### Sutton legal action begins

The first step in legal proceedings between a citizens' group and the Town of Sutton began Wednesday.

Lawyers for both sides met in court for a matter of minutes, to decide on a schedule of events leading up to the presentation of a case before a judge.

First on the agenda will be the interrogation of Robert Benoit, the citizen representing the *Regroupement pour un Développement Durable à Sutton*, by Town of Sutton lawyers. The deadline for the questioning is Sept. 25.

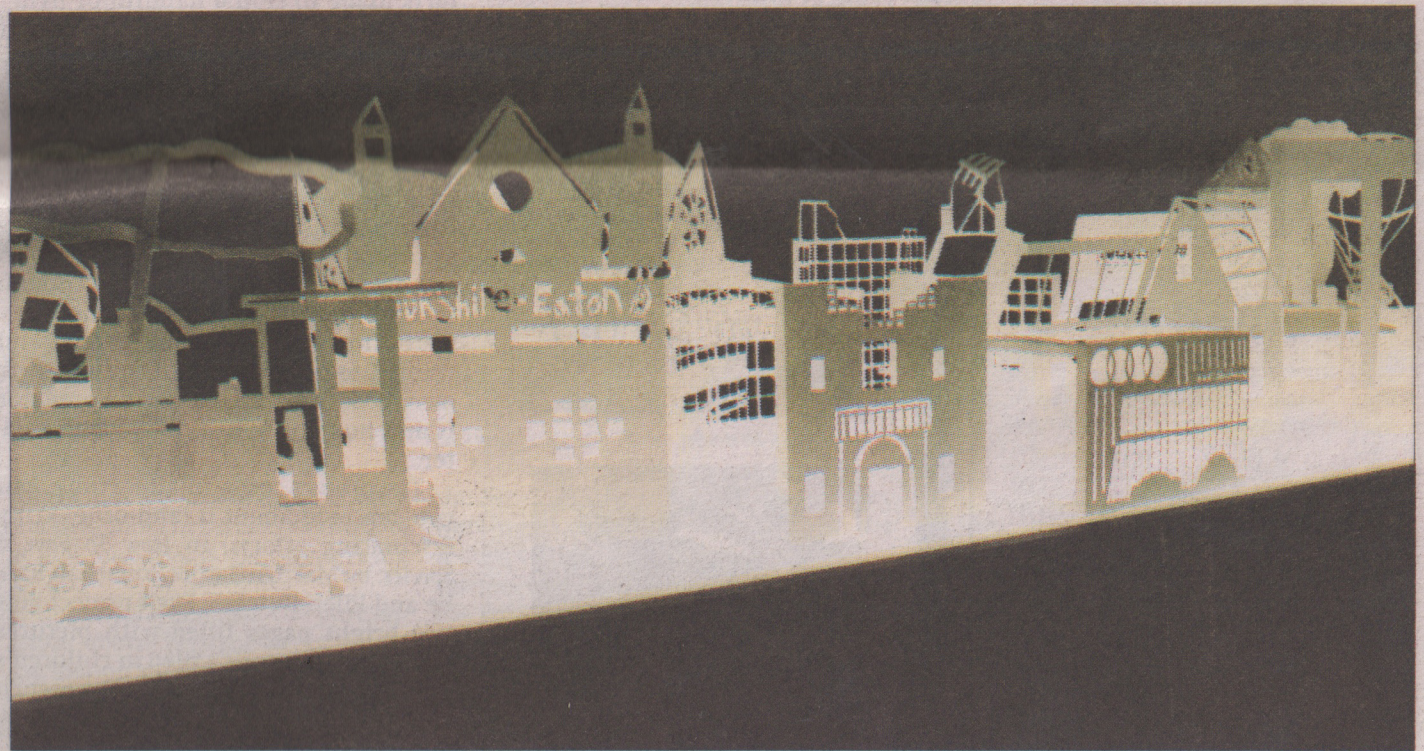
RDDS lawyers then have until Oct. 30 to question Sutton town manager Jean-François D'Amour and Réal Girard, director of urban planning, who will speak on behalf of the town.

According to Benoit, there will be no word on the interlocutory injunction before the end of November, and the request to nullify bylaws 254 and 256 will take much longer.

Benoit said lawyers for both sides have a deadline of Nov. 27 to file a request to the court asking a judge to hear their arguments, based on preliminary research and interrogations.

Benoit said that at Tuesday's town council meeting, Sutton council would not comment or answer any questions at the meeting regarding the two bylaws, saying the matter is currently before the courts.
